

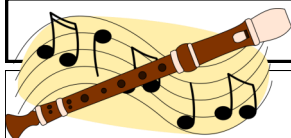

## **Building Renovations**

The officers of the church have approved refurbishing the Sanctuary this summer. The last major renovation to the Sanctuary occurred in the late 80s. Here are the details of the upcoming refurbishment:

1. Work is scheduled to begin on Monday, May 20 and will be completed no later than August 31.
2. All worship services will be held in the gymnasium during the refurbishment project (beginning May 26).
3. During the refurbishment, the entire sanctuary floor will be closed for safety reasons.
4. Work to be performed: repaint sanctuary and hallways, full refinishing of pews and upholstery, new carpet, rework some of the chancel and choir loft area to better accommodate needs, lighting, and moving floor vents. The sanctuary restrooms will also be refurbished during this time.

The officers have also approved refurbishing the restrooms on the basement and 3rd floors. These bathrooms will be closed 4/29-5/10. Please use restrooms on the office, sanctuary, and gym floors during this time.
