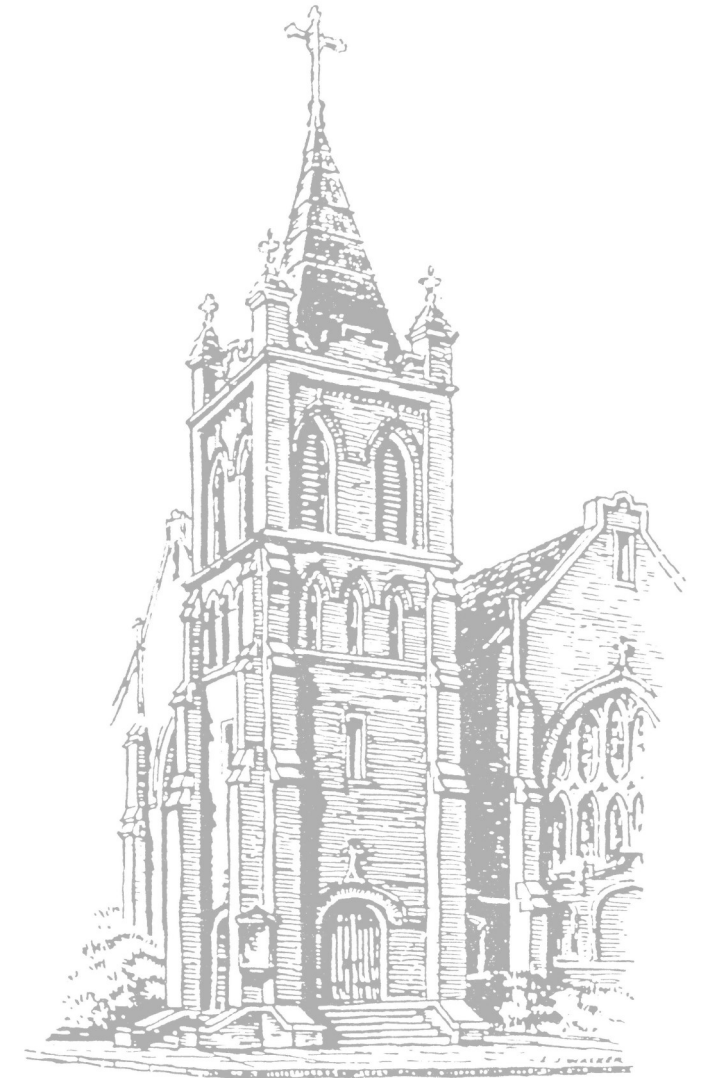
*My Master in a garden lay, perfumed with spices rare,
