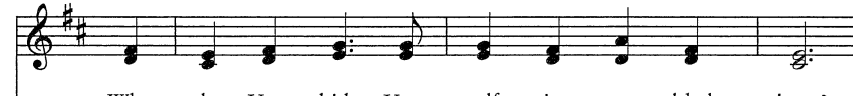

And so he thinks, "God has for - got - ten this;



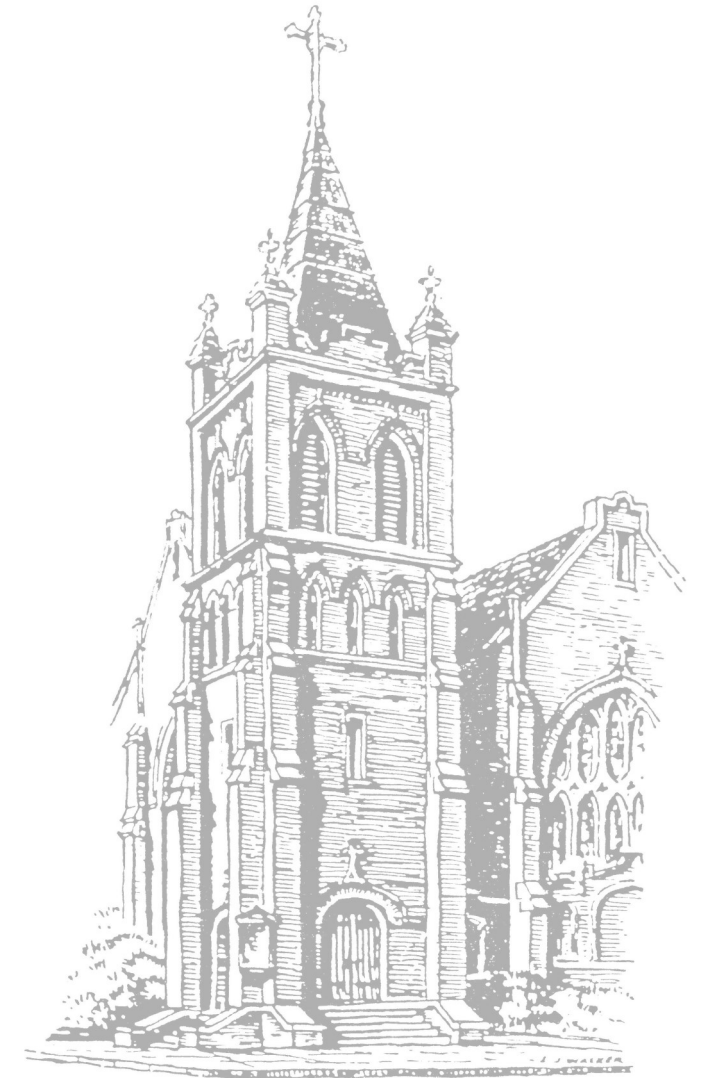
The greed - y he com - mends, but spurns the LORD.
