 3. On You, O God, my soul has called, For You will an-swer me.

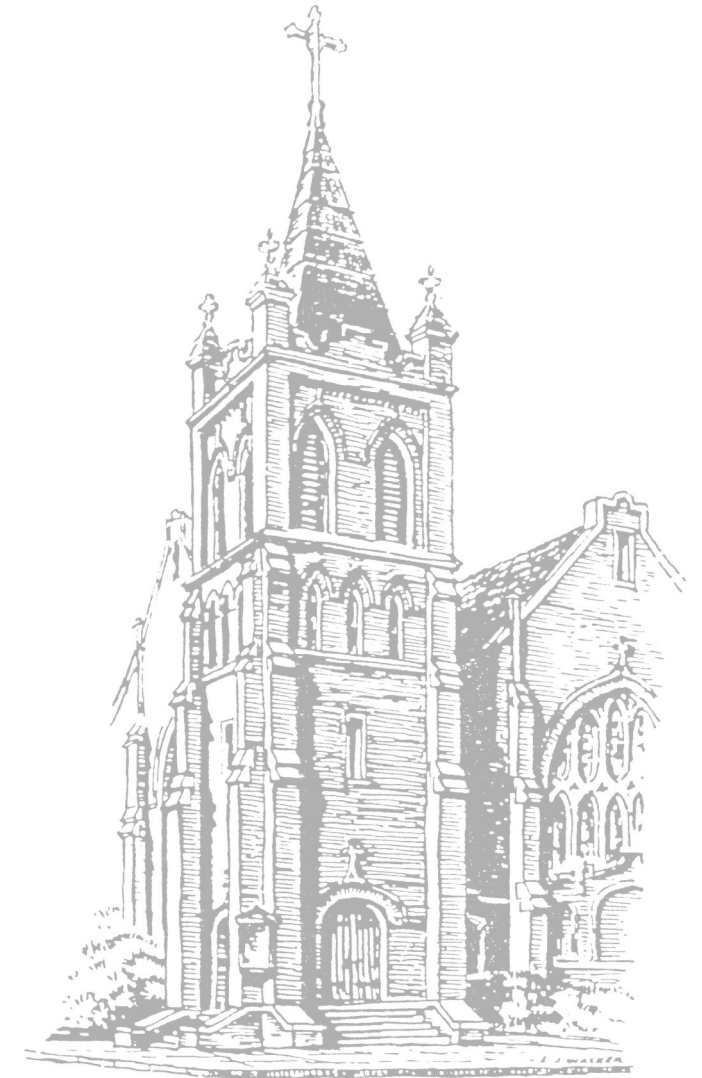
Give Your at - ten-tion to my prayer, For my lips do not lie.
