#### IV. Statement

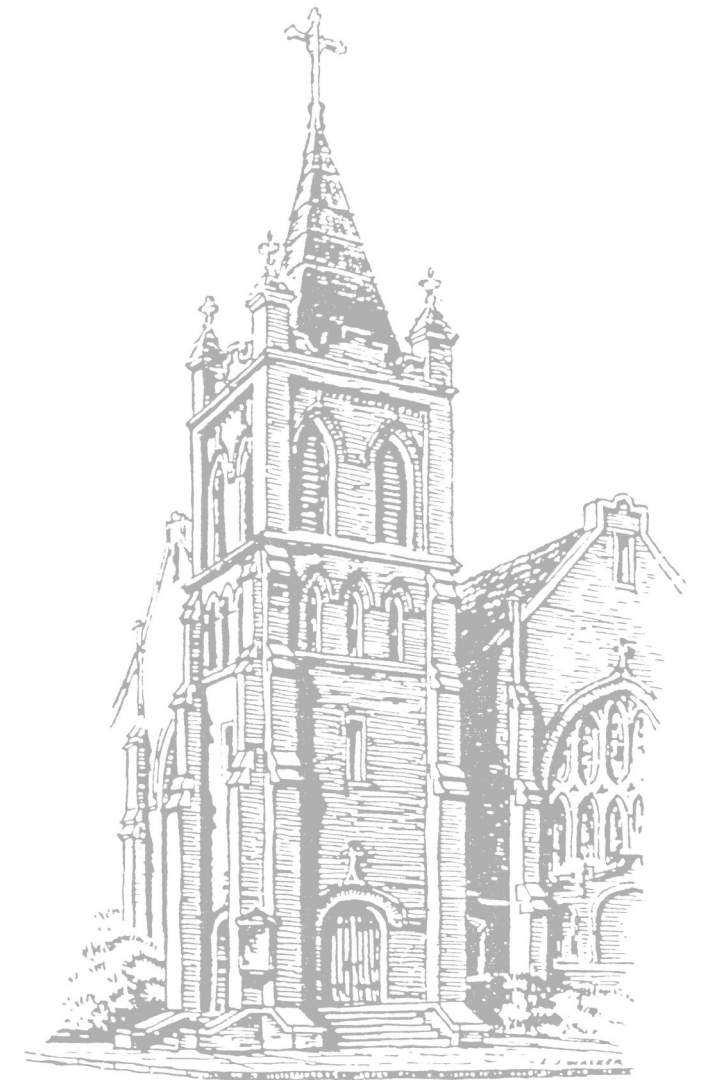
