 But they who tru-ly seek the LORD Will not lack an-y good.

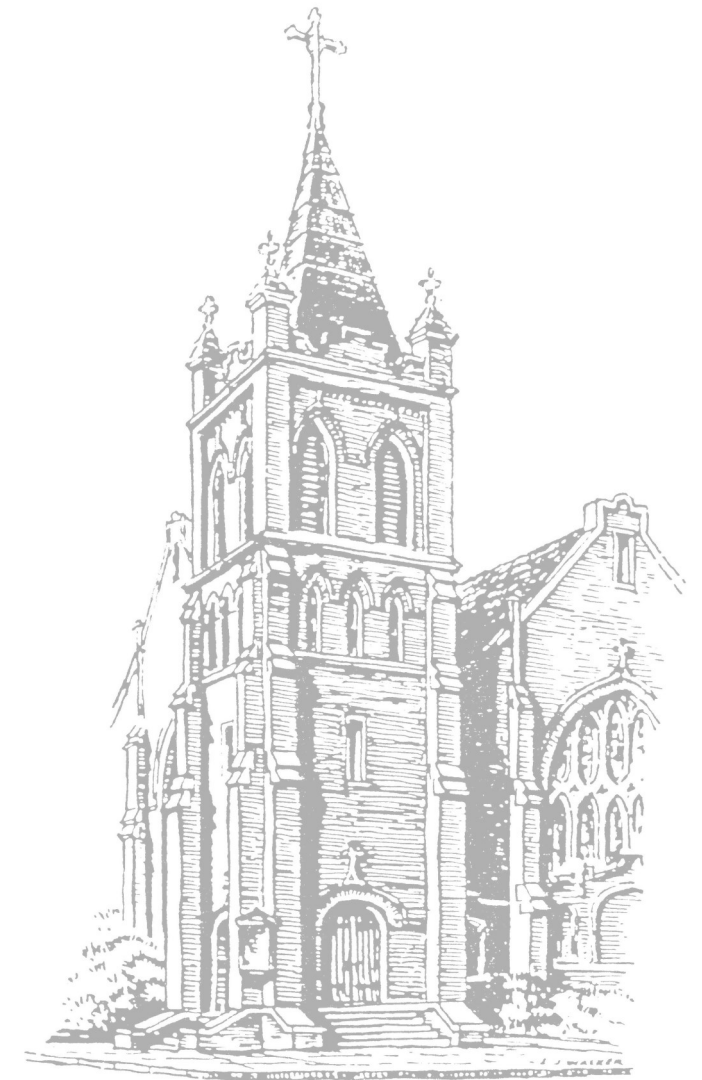
