And I will tell your great - ness, LORD, and praise you all my days.



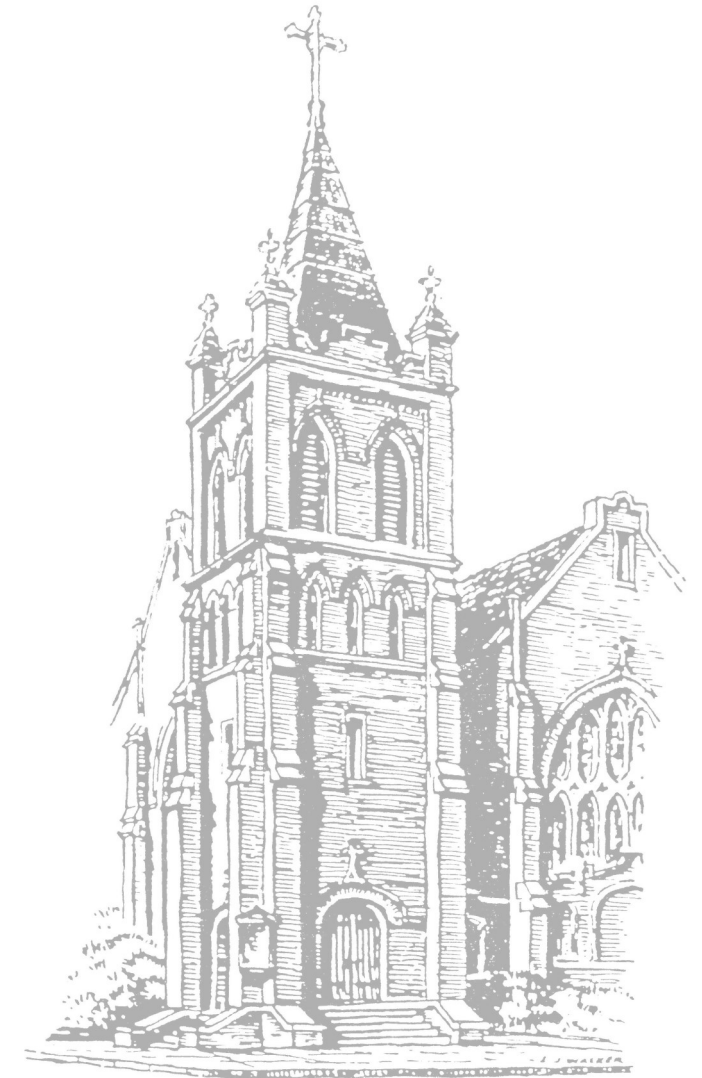
