### About 100 Years Ago At Second Presbyterian

On June 17, 1910, the session met to express the church's gratitude for the "completion of our beautiful and modern church located on the corner of River and Rhett Streets; and that on this the first Sabbath on which we worship in the new building, we express this appreciation by a unanimous rising vote."

At the session meeting of June 20, 1909, the elders held a "brief conference ... in reference to the purchase of an organ for the new Church; but no conclusion was reached and the matter was postponed to a subsequent meeting for further consideration."

The announcements for June 22, 1913 informed the congregation that, "It is our ambition to see the basement of the Church completed for social and Sunday School purposes and to see a new pipe organ installed. The Church will then be complete, with the exception of a few minor improvements." The recently constructed church, which is the current property, had been occupied in June of 1910.

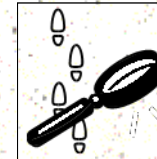

- ⇒ Contributions in May 2012 were \$74,216 versus budget of \$83,148.
- ⇒ YTD contributions are \$404,024 vs. \$382,288 for the same period in 2011.
- ⇒ Through May 2012, actual contributions are behind budget by \$11,715.
- ⇒ Operating expenses for May 2012, were \$72,754 versus the budget of \$73,462.
- ⇒ Three months of missionary commitments were made in May 2012. Missionaries have been paid one half of their annual commitment.
- ⇒ In addition, \$78,591 was paid for the work related to the stain glass windows and \$164,300 was paid related to the purchase of 225 S. Academy Street property.

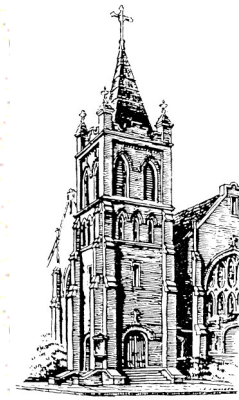

## Letter from the Church Administrator "A Plenteous Potpourri of Property and Presbyteriana"

Did you know you can register for Vacation Bible School online? Did you know that there is a marvelous marriage conference awaiting us at the end of the summer? Did you know that our summer mission teams are working hard to finish raising support? Did you know there is a huge need for men to volunteer on a local service project? Did you know that all our Pastors are traveling over the next month? Did you know the Deacons are busy with our new building?

A few words about summertime and Second Church.

### Property Update

Second Presbyterian Church is now the owner of 225 South Academy Street. A down payment of \$164,300 was paid in the middle of May out of a final purchase price of \$800,000. When reconciled with other funds previously paid to the owner, Second Church is responsible to pay an additional \$625,000 over 20 years at 5% interest with a 5 year "balloon note." Our monthly payment will be \$4,124.72 or \$49,496.68 a year. Long Range Planning Committee Chairman John Gray negotiated the terms of the deal with approval and input of both the Session and the Board. The church approved the purchase of new property in a congregational meeting last fall and the trustees signed the contract.

The church has secured a 5 year rental agreement (new lease begins in August 2012) with ARC Greenville (existing tenant at the property) during the first 3 years amounting to \$67,500 year. In years 4 & 5 rental income will increase to \$75,000 per annum. We (SPC) are responsible for taxes, insurance and 1/2 of HVAC maintenance on items over \$1500. We are grateful to Mr. Gray, the committee and the Trustees for the many hours of service given to the church on this project. The officers have estimated that rental income will allow us to cover yearly costs associated with the purchase, and any additional revenue (if any) will be applied to property reserve and maintenance funds.

In lieu of hiring a property management service the Diaconate through its Property Committee has taken on the task of initiating property improvements to the building and support systems at 225 South Academy. Don Wardlaw is the manager of the ARC Greenville company in the building. Pray for our Deacons as they learn a new building and study ways to steward this new facility for the Glory of God. Pray for our officers and our Long Range Planning Committee as they plan to utilize this new part of campus with an eye towards our Gospel witness. We are grateful to our deacons, especially the Property Committee
