Altogether there are over 500 hours of content, including videos on the website. Incredibly over the last 5 years over 80,000 people have downloaded a SPC sermon from the website or at sermonaudio.com. The church also blogs on history and topical events at RiverandRhett.com and publishes some of our pastoral letters at WestEndHerald.com

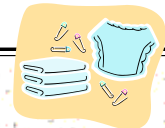

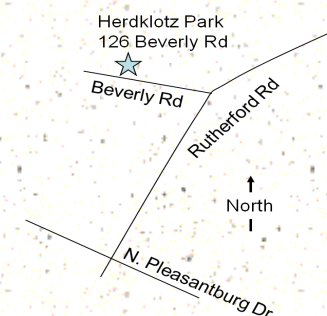

Our Website has an expression on the front page underneath our church's name- *For Christ in South Carolina and the World*. This is at the heart of what we are trying to accomplish in providing information and promoting the church's mission online.

The website tells a watching world "WHO WE ARE" including: A welcome message, a description of the Gospel, biographies, pictures of our Elders, Deacons and Staff, a welcome letter from the Senior Minister, links and a map to churches within Calvary Presbytery and the PCA.

The "MEMBERSHIP" Page is privileged content only for church members who have registered to the site. Please register by going to the Membership Page and creating an account. It's very easy to do. Inside you will find: Prayer list subscription information, this week's Intercessor (archive of old Intercessors), full access to all church ministry calendars and the Church Policy Manual.

The general Church "CALENDAR" can be seen @*Second Presbyterian Church Greenville* and shows planned events on our church campus. Each ministry at SPC has its own sub-calendar including: Women in the Church, Nursery Workers Schedule, Youth and Family events, Sports and Fellowship, Ushering & Counting, Elders Leading in Worship, Missions and Evangelism. We have also created a list for birthdays and anniversaries.

"MINISTRIES" pages detail the work and mission of: Women in the Church (WIC), Men's Ministry (Men of the Covenant), Seniors Ministry (Young at Heart), Youth & Families, Music & the Fine Arts, Sports and Fellowship and the CAT-Kids.
