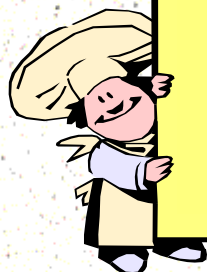

**CHRISTIANITY 101**

**Baptism (Credobaptism vs Paedobaptism)**

*Paedobaptism* means baptizing children. The Greek word *pais* means "child." This belief is in contradistinction to *credobaptism*, Credo coming from the Latin word meaning "I believe," and describes the religious practice of "Believers only Baptism." The majority of people professing faith in Jesus Christ in the world today and the majority of Christians in every age past have practiced *Paedobaptism*.

*Baptism is a sacrament of the New Testament, ordained by Jesus Christ, not only for the solemn admission of the party baptized into the visible Church; but also to be unto him a sign and seal of the covenant of grace, of his ingrafting into Christ, of regeneration of remission of sins and of his giving up unto God, through Jesus Christ, to walk in the newness of life. Which sacrament is, by Christ's own appointment, to be continued in His Church until the end of the world.*

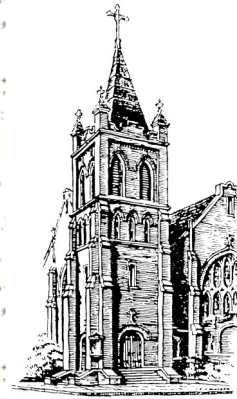

We will hear of the work to establish Christ Church Charleston and the exciting things that are taking place in that historic city.
