**Letter from Piedmont Women' Center**

Dear Second Presbyterian Church

For the past several years, Piedmont Women's Center has offered churches and groups the opportunity to minister to women in the Upstate of South Carolina through a Baby Bottle Campaign. The monies raised during a Baby Bottle Campaign are used to help fund our ultrasound program. Our ultrasound program confirms to the pregnant woman that the baby she is carrying is a real, live baby.

The concept is simple, but God uses it in a mighty way. Last year we received local mission support from church families in the Greenville area to help fund the operating costs of our ultrasound program. Over 600 free limited OB ultrasounds were performed because of this generous giving. Many of the women who received an ultrasound were not considering abortion. However, we do know of hundreds of women who had

planned to have an abortion but instead chose life as a result of their ultrasound.

Our aspiration to provide free ultrasounds that encourage women to choose life is an ongoing, yearlong mission, and the costs continue throughout the year. Therefore, a Baby Bottle Campaign event is appropriate any time during the year.

We are so grateful for your desire to support us through this exciting Baby Bottle Campaign project and make it possible to give women an opportunity to view their baby for the first time through an ultrasound.

May God bless you and your church family this year in the work that you do for His kingdom.

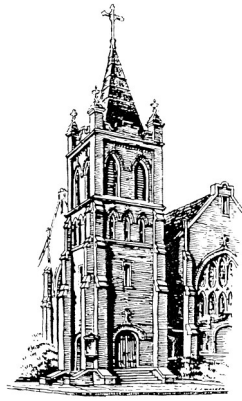

**Letter from Rev. Jeff Windt

Dear Second Presbyterian Church Family,

I want to ask you to consider joining me on our upcoming short-term mission trip to Cherokee, NC.
